



ART CONSERVATORY POLICIES

Class Attire: Art conservatory students should wear modest, comfortable attire that is not a concern if splashed by paint.

Class Decorum: Art conservatory students are required to abide by the **TCH Code of Conduct** to ensure that the classroom remains a safe space for all of our students.

Art Projects:

- Each student will be working on the student's own individual project.
- There's no time limit on completion of the project.
- Some weeks, students will be drawing; some weeks, students will be painting; and other weeks, students will be doing both.
- These classes are for beginning and advanced artists. We focus on the needs and interests of each student, helping them enhance individual skills, making complete projects more dynamic.

Art Passes:

- Art classes work on a pass-schedule.
- This pass allows the student to attend 4 or 8 hours worth of classes (depending on which hour pass you purchase) within **One Year**.
- The student can attend one day a week, two days a week, or once a month.
- They are welcome to stay at each class for an hour, or they can stay for two or three hours that evening if that's what you choose to do.
- Once they use up their 4 or 8 hour pass, they simply purchase* a new pass.
- Once a student is enrolled in the system, you will need to call 913-393-3141, email accounts@culturehouse.com, or stop by the front desk for additional class passes.
- **Passes expire within one year. There are no refunds for art class passes.**

- We can pro-rate class passes at the end of the semester.
- Summer art classes have a different schedule from spring and fall and will be posted separately.
